

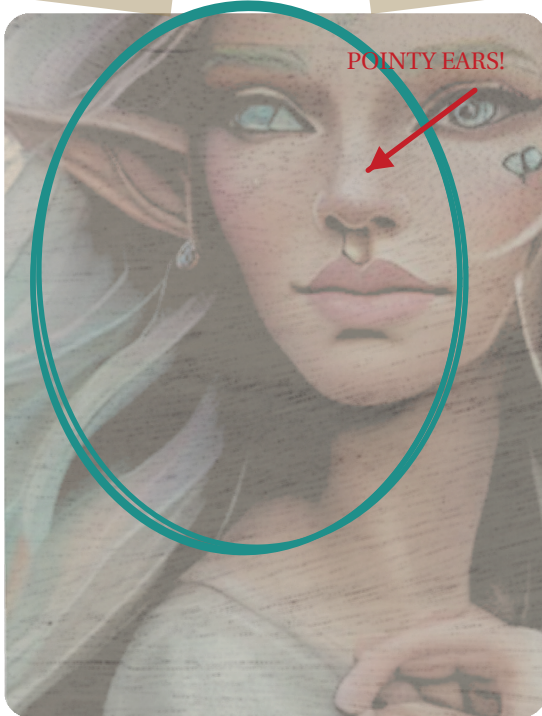

A silver-green thread found on a bramble. Could be Elven clothing. Could be tinsel.



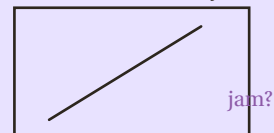
ITEM B

A tiny map marked "PICNIC AFTER JUMP". Location inconveniently smudged with jam.



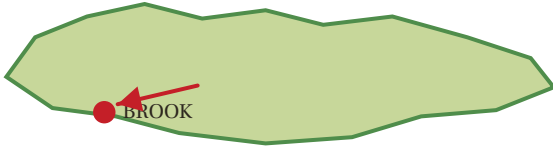
FULL CASE RESTRICTED
COMMITTED QUESTORS ARMED WITH A PASS ONLY



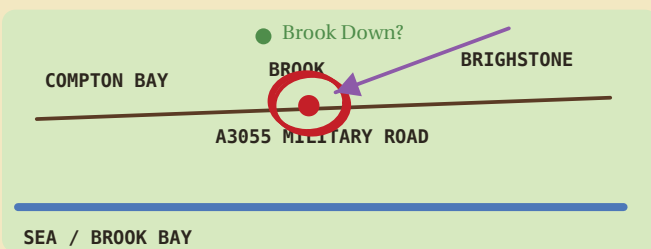
RUMOURS, EVIDENCE & QUESTIONS
