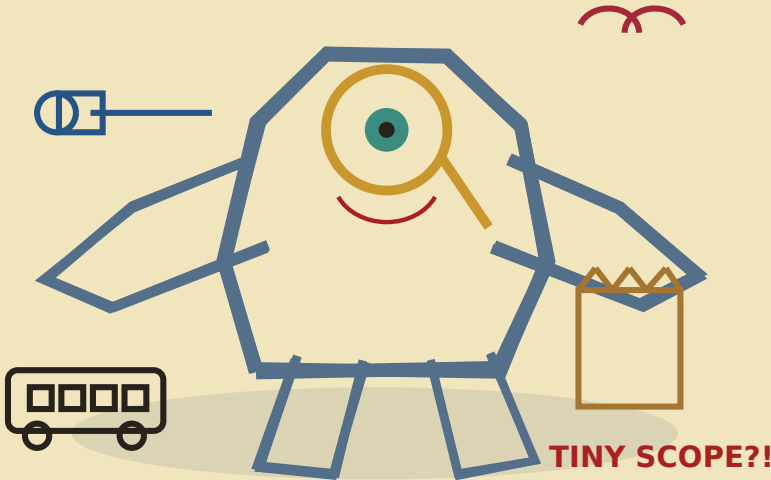


UNVERIFIED CREATURE DOSSIER

THE TINY TELESCOPE

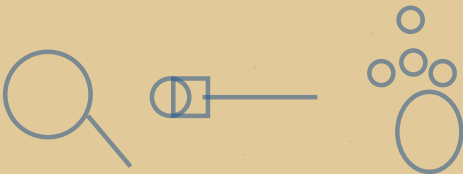
A twelve-foot figure studied Yaverland through a telescope shorter than a baguette. It allegedly spotted a gull stealing chips in Bembridge.

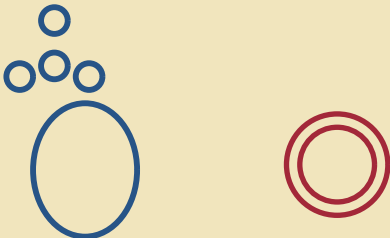
FULL CASE RESTRICTED - PASS REQUIRED
