LOCAL RUMOURS & ALLEGED SIGHTINGS

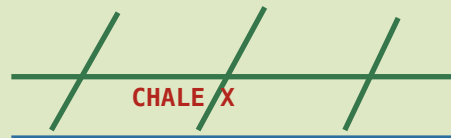
- Horses near Chale allegedly turn their ears whenever Puck speaks.
