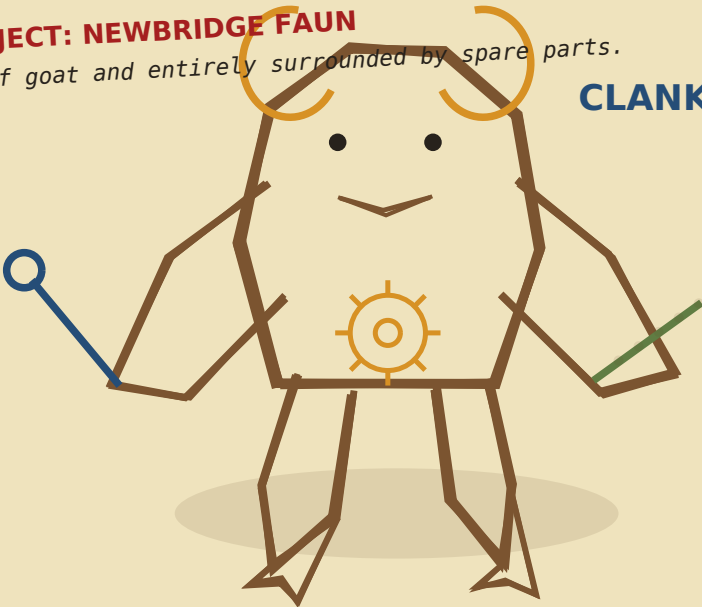
assembled from flute notes, flour clouds and loose machinery

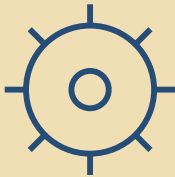
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ASSUMED CHARACTERISTICS
