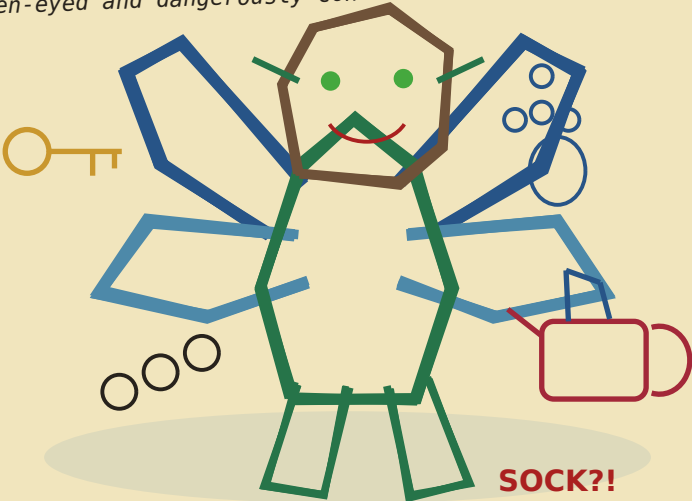


UNVERIFIED CREATURE DOSSIER

WINGS	Blue, iridescent and faster than key-counting
VOICE	Tiny laugh with surprisingly large echo
DIET	Moon biscuits and crumbs left near puzzle boxes
WEAKNESS	Polite wolves, labelled drawers and tied teapots
TALENT	Hiding objects, illusions and gnome choreography
