

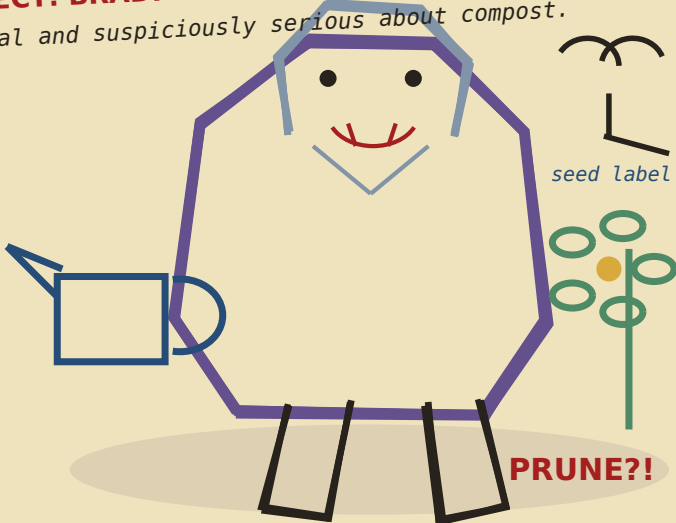

THE LABEL THIEVES

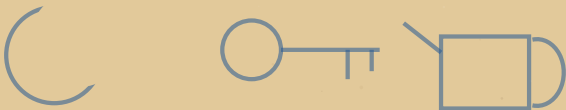
