

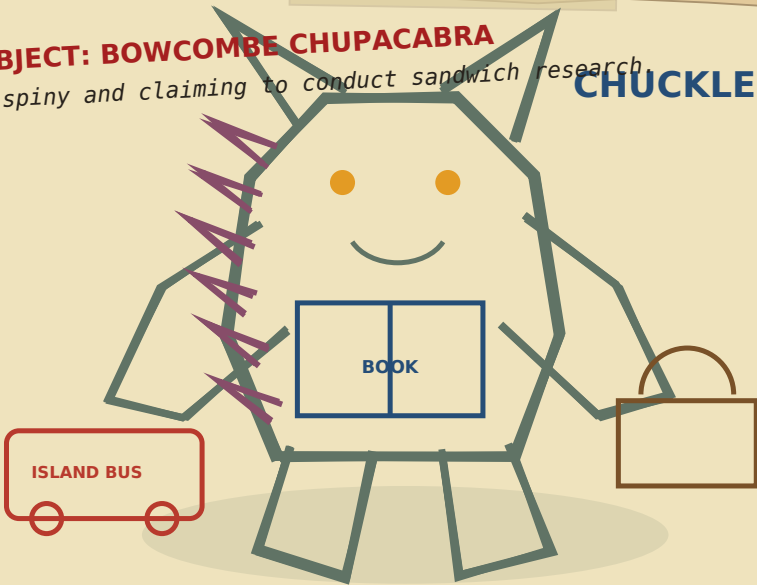
UNVERIFIED CREATURE DOSSIER
