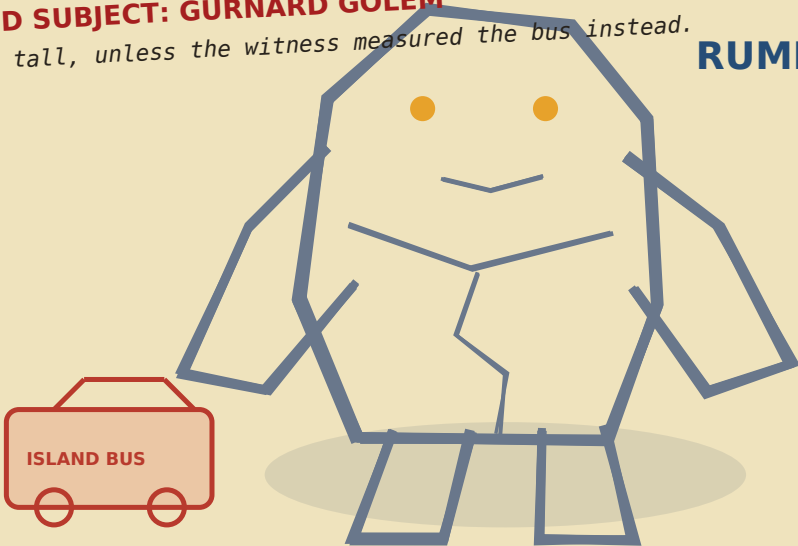

TALENT	Lifting the impossible without showing off

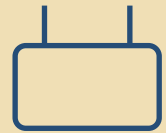
SPECULATIVE 'EVIDENCE'
