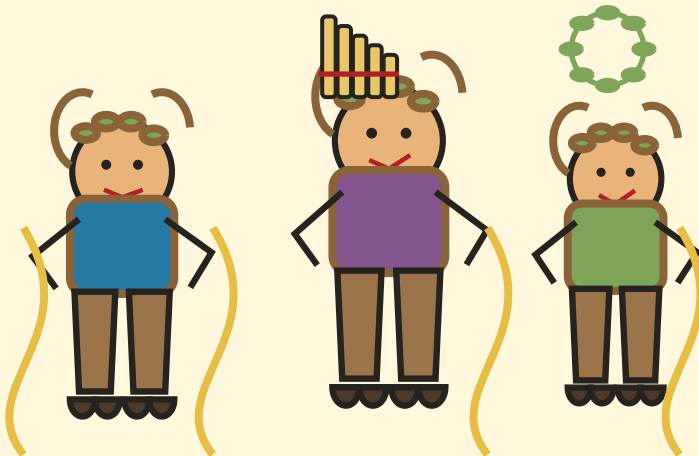
CASE 25 / WROXALL SATYRS
